4. **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

There were no comments from the public.

5. CONSENT AGENDA:

a. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETING HELD AUGUST 8, 2023.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve the items under consent agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

6. PRESENTATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE FINANCIAL AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2022.

Jonathan Hall of CRI, the city's auditors, presented the highlights of the audit for the most recent fiscal year. He noted that there were no findings regarding the city's internal controls. There was a positive change overall net position over the previous fiscal year. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve the financial audit for fiscal year ending September 30, 2022. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

7. PRESENTATION BY INFRAMARK REGARDING OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF WATER AND WASTEWATER FACILITIES.

George Quilantan addressed the commission regarding needed improvements at the water and wastewater facilities. He also presented a video explaining the wastewater process. There was no action

taken on this item.

8. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ENTERING INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH LA FERIA IRRIGATION DISTRICT CAMERON COUNTY NO. 3.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve the interlocal agreement with La Feria Iffigation District Cameron County No. 3. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

9. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE LFIDC ACTION TO AWARD CONTRACT FOR CLEANUP OF LFIDC-OWNED PROPERTY CONSISTING OF 22 ACRES ON RABB ROAD.

Mr. Ortiz explained that the site had been used to dump scraps and materials during street improvement projects several years ago. The cleanup project should take between two to three months to complete. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve LFIDC action to award contract for cleanup of LFIDC-owned property consisting of 22 acres on Rabb Road. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

Mayor Maldonado called the meeting into closed session at 7:27 pm.
