3. DETERMINE QUORUM PRESENT AND CALL MEETING TO ORDER - MAYOR

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no comments from the public during this item.

5. CONSENT AGENDA:

- a. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETING HELD JULY 25, 2023.
- b. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR CITY COMMISSION MEETING HELD JULY 31, 2023.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve the items under consent agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

6. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE A PROPOSED TAX RATE CALCULATION FOR TAX YEAR 2023 (FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024) AND SET DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING.

Mr. Rios explained that the tax rate will remain the same as the previous fiscal year. Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve the proposed tax rate and set a public hearing for September 15, 2023. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

7. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON CHANGE ORDER #1 WITH GMC TRANSPORT, LLC FOR WATER PLANT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.</u>

The change order represents a \$23,070 decrease in the contract amount. Commissioner Garcia made a motion to approve change order #1 with GMC Transport, LLC for water plant improvement project. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lozano and passed unanimously.
