There were no comments from the public.

Commissioner Garcia made a motion to approve the items under consent agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lozano and passed unanimously.

6. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2023-21 SETTING THE TAX RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024.</u>

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve resolution 2023-21 setting the tax rate at .76 per \$100 valuation for fiscal year 2023-2024. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Zuniga and passed unanimously.

7. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2023-22 APPROVING THE CITY OF LA FERIA INVESTMENT POLICY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024.</u>

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-22 approving the City of La Feria investment policy for fiscal year 2023-2024. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

8. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2023-23 ESTABLISHING

HOLIDAYS TO BE OBSERVED IN FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-23 establishing holidays to be observed in fiscal year 2023-2024. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

9. <u>DISCUSS, CONSIDER, AND ADOPT RESOLUTION 2023-24 TO DESIGNATE AUTHORIZED SIGNATORIES FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT – DISASTER RECOVERY (CDBG-DR) PROGRAM FOR GLO STATE CONTRACT NUMBER 23-152-002-E069.</u>

Commissioner Martinez made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-24 to designate authorized signatories for the Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program for Glo State Contract Number 23-152-002-E069. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lozano and passed unanimously.

10. <u>DISCUSS</u>, CONSIDER, AND ADOPT RESOLUTION 2023-25 REGARDING CIVIL RIGHTS WHICH INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING POLICIES: CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN AND GRIEVANCE PROCEDURES; SECTION 3 POLICY; EXCESSIVE FORCE POLICY; LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY (LEP) STANDARDS PLAN; SECTION 504 POLICY AND GRIEVANCE PROCEDURES; CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY; AND FAIR HOUSING POLICY.

Commissioner Lozano mad a motion to approve Resolution 2023-25 regarding civil rights which includes the following policies: citizen participation plan and grievance procedures; section 3 policy; excessive force policy; limited English proficiency (LEP) standards plan; section 504 policy and grievance procedures; code of conduct policy; and fair housing policy. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

- 11. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 2023-26 AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATION FOR LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM. There was no action taken on this item.

AND THE CITY OF LA FERIA FOR THE PREPARATION OF A REGIONAL TEXAS POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (TPDES) STORMWATER PERMIT APPLICATION AND STORMWATER PROGRAM PLAN.

Commissioner Lozano made a motion to approve the mayor to sign a memorandum of agreement between the Lower Rio Grande Valley TPDES Stormwater Taskforce Partnership, Inc. and the city of La Feria for the preparation of a regional Texas pollutant discharge elimination system (TPDES) stormwater permit application and stormwater program plan. The motion was seconded by

Commissioner Martinez and passed unanimously.

16. <u>CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN</u> TROPICAL TEXAS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND THE CITY OF LA FERIA.

Commissioner Martinez made a motion to approve the interlocal agreement between Tropical Texas Behavioral Health and City of La Feria. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia and passed unanimously.

17. <u>INFRAMARK MONTHLY REPORT REGARDING WATER AND WASTEWATER</u> FACILITY OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE.

George Quilantan addressed the commission regarding the City's drought contingency plan and explained the conditions that trigger water conservation regulations. There was no action taken on this item.
